Travel Survey Support and Accessibility Reporting

Overview

TPS delivered the travel survey programme on behalf of the Sustainability Team at Northumbria University in 2015, 2018, 2020 and 2022.

In addition to the ongoing travel survey programmes, TPS were also appointed in 2022 to complete a baseline assessment of the accessibility of both the main and Coach Lane campuses. This assessment considered how the accessibility of each campus could be improved and enhanced. It was later identified where initiatives being delivered by other stakeholders could be taken advantage of by the University such as the rollout of the e-scooter pilot, Council EV charging strategies and local bus service enhancements.
